Petition and Authorization to Register for CSC 4999 Honors Thesis

One of the requirements of departmental honors is the completion of an honors thesis (CSC 4999). Prior to registering for CSC 4999, the student must identify computer science instructor holding a graduate faculty appointment, which can be found here.

The student should discuss with the faculty the terms of the thesis project. The thesis typically requires a minimum of 20 pages of substantial computer science content. Once agreed upon, the student must complete this form, submit a two-page proposal outlining the nature of the research question, and obtain the faculty member's approval and signature.

Next, the student must submit the form and proposal to their assigned academic advisor, who will forward the information to the departmental faculty honors advisor for approval. Upon approval, the student's assigned academic advisor will submit the registration override for CSC 4999.

Finally, the student must register for the course through the registration website.
