



AGRADE REQUEST FORM

Students entering into their final year of undergraduate coursework may apply to a College of Engineering Graduate program under the AGRADE status provided they meet the following requirements:

- Minimum overall 3.3 overall GPA and 3.45 major GPA
- A maximum of 16 credits may be applied towards both undergraduate and graduate degrees
- The earliest date by which a student may apply for the AGRADE program is during the semester in which he/she completes 90 credits toward the undergraduate degree.
- Fulfill all other AGRADE requirements as outlined in the WSU Graduate Bulletin (www.bulletins.wayne.edu)
- Submit AGRADE Request Form and AGRADE Plan of Work signed by the undergraduate Academic Advisor and Graduate Program Officer verifying student eligibility
- Submit a complete online Application for Graduate Admission at <https://gradslate.wayne.edu/apply/> before the semester beginning MS program.
